On behalf of the Assembly of Delegates, the legislative body of the regional government known as Barnstable County please accept this letter in order to clarify our position relative to correspondence that your office has received regarding this D.P.U. filing.


It has come to the attention of the Assembly that BCK Law, PC has expressed in their official correspondence that their office is representing Barnstable County's position on matters relating to Cape Light Compact, specifically DPU filing 14-69 (See attached letter to your office dated July 8, 2014). On August 6, 2014 at a regular scheduled meeting of the Assembly of Delegates, a motion was made and subsequent, affirmative vote taken, to apprise your office of our official position regarding this correspondence from BCK Law.

Please be advised that the Barnstable County Assembly of Delegates has not and will not endorse the actions or opinions of the Cape Light Compact or their counsel, BCK Law, PC, as it relates to their refusal to comply with the Office of the Attorney General's information requests.

To the contrary, the Assembly has been engaged in its' own inquiry relating to the manner in which the Cape Light Compact conducts business and has previously requested the assistance from both the Office of the Attorney General and the Office of the Inspector General. Many of the questions and most of the relevant documentation requested in the Attorney General's filing were sought in the Assembly's inquiry. However, like the Office of the Attorney General, we found the Cape Light Compact and their counsel to be selectively cooperative with our requests for information.

Please know that the Assembly of Delegates is available to you and your office for any questions or evidence we have relating to this matter.
